

**MINISTERIAL REGULATION**  
**PRESCRIBING RATES FOR PAYMENT OF DEPOSIT AND CONTRIBUTION,**  
**B.E. 2558 (2015)\***

By virtue of section 4 paragraph one, section 31 paragraph one and section 32 paragraph two of the National Savings Fund Act, B.E. 2554 (2011), the Minister of Finance hereby issues the Ministerial Regulation as follows:

**Clause 1.** A member shall make a deposit to the Fund in the amount not less than fifty baht per month but not more than thirteen thousand and two hundred baht in total for that calendar year.

**Clause 2.** The Government shall pay a contribution to the Fund for a member at the rates as follows:

(1) in the case where the member is not more than thirty years of age, it shall pay a contribution at the rate of fifty per cent of the deposit made by the member to the Fund, provided that the total amount shall not be more than six hundred baht for that calendar year;

(2) in the case where the member is more than thirty years but not more than fifty years of age, it shall pay a contribution at the rate of eighty per cent of the deposit made by the member to the Fund, provided that the total amount shall not be more than nine hundred and sixty baht for that calendar year;

(3) in the case where the member is more than fifty years of age, it shall pay a contribution at the rate of one hundred per cent of the deposit made by the member to the Fund, provided that the total amount shall not be more than one thousand and two hundred baht for that calendar year.

Note: - The reason for the promulgation of this Ministerial Regulation is as follows. Whereas section 31 of the National Savings Fund Act, B.E. 2554 (2011) provides that a member of the National Savings Fund shall make a deposit to the National Savings Fund in the amount not less than fifty baht per month but not more than the amount prescribed by a Ministerial Regulation, and section 32 of such Act provides that the Government shall pay a contribution in correspondence with age of a member and in the proportion under the schedule of contributions, provided that the amount of the contribution must not exceed the amount prescribed by a Ministerial Regulation, it is therefore necessary to issue this Ministerial Regulation.
